

Webcam of Pier 6 Playground Progress!

RAL Companies & Affiliates LLC, the developer of One Brooklyn Bridge Park (360 Furman Street) has placed a web-camera on the roof of their building that transmits digital photographs of the on-going Pier 6 construction. Put in place in early August 2009, the web-cam provides a fascinating picture of the day-to-day progress on Pier 6, particularly the 1.6 acre destination playground (*see renderings below*). The amoeba-like shape in the middle is the playground sandbox. Closer to Furman Street is Slide Mountain, where you can see the timber seating areas nearly completed. Check in daily to see how Swing Valley (the portion of the pier shown in upper left) takes shape. The webcam will capture the placing of soils, and paving of park paths, as well as the installation of hand-crafted wooden play equipment and the completion of the water play areas and lush plantings that will make this section of the park a real delight.
